



The 2019 WRCA Ranch Horse Show will be **Friday, November 8** and **Saturday, November 9**.

Wrangler, Ranch Hand, and Junior Classes will compete on **Friday from 7- 11 a.m.**

Senior Class competition will be held **Friday from 4-5 p.m.**

Cowboy Class and Box Drive competition will be **Saturday from 7 – 10 a.m.**

Each class is limited as follows: Wrangler-10; Ranch Hand-15; Junior-15; Senior-10; Cowboy-20, Box Drive-10. There will be a limit of 2 horses per cowboy per day.

The 2019 WRCA Ranch Horse Show is sanctioned with the Ranch Horse Association of America (RHAA). The top horses will be eligible to compete at the RHAA Finals. This year, the WRCA is also offering a concurrent qualifying AQHA Ranching Heritage Challenge competition.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY

Books open October 1. **Please do not postmark entries BEFORE Sept. 27. Your entry will not be processed until ALL ENTRIES POSTMARKED CORRECTLY have been processed.** *That means you may not get entered!* You are better off to make sure you have everything you need before you send it to me and postmark it on or after Sept. 27, than to send me a partially complete or early postmarked entry packet and there be a delay in the process. If you have more than one entry, please *make a copy of the blank entry form and competition license (or proof of ownership for a day permit) for each horse/entry/class.* If I have to make copies for you, it **will** delay your entry.

Books close October 30. After that date, a vet/doctor release will be necessary to get your entry fees refunded. Last minute scratches may be subject to stock charges.

You will be notified by mail to confirm your entry, but feel free to call me (Jodi) for confirmation as well.

Things you need to mail to the Ranch Horse Show Secretary:
You are not entered without all of the following.

- completed entry form **for each entry** including current membership number/day permit
- copy of RHAA competition license (or proof of ownership for a day permit) **for each entry**
- verification of employment if rider is competing on employer's horse (please see the Employment verification section on the entry form)
- entry fees made payable to WRCA
 - \$140 RHAA entry fee (**separate check for each entry**)
 - \$55 AQHA entry fee (**separate check for each concurrent entry**)
- release of liability form **signed by rider**, (Parent signature if rider is under 18 years of age.)
On a separate page, NOT on the back of any pages –Save a tree somewhere else.

Please be sure your RHAA membership or your day permit will be current at the show. It is best to have them renewed before you send me your entry. *You are not entered until you are on the "RHAA current member" list or proof of day permit and/or competition license is verified by RHAA.* Do not write "pending" on your entry form and think that you are entered. *You are not entered until I have all of the items from the above list.*

****Checks are not deposited until after the WCRR. Any checks returned due to non-sufficient funds will result in a ban from any future WRCA Ranch Horse Shows****
